#### Rules and Expectations Book

While attending the CFTF AHS Summer camp, these are the rules and expectations that will be expected for the duration of this summer camp:

#### Parents/Caregivers

- 1. Be respectful towards the staff and the summer program.
  - No swearing or bullying will be tolerated.
- 2. Have your child arrive on time and picked up on time.
  - Punctuality is a must as there will be outings that will be planned.
- 3. Regular attendance will be expected.
  - There may be a waiting list for other children wanting to attend.
- 4. Confidentiality will be expected.
  - No gossiping or talking about other children who may be in the program.
- 5. Do not send sick children to the summer camp.
  - Inform staff if your child will be missing due to illness.
- 6. Parental involvement will be required as part of the Head Start component.
  - You will be expected to participate once a week during this program.
  - Examples: Attend field trips, assist with lunch preparation, reading to the children, sanitizing, spending time with your child in the program, etc.

#### What I Need to Send with my Child

- 1. Extra change of clothes and a backpack.
- 2. Indoor pair of shoes.
- 3. Outdoors runners: no flip flops, crocs, slides or sandals.
- 4. Jacket and a hat.
- 5. Swimming days: Bathing suit and towel.
- 6. Label all of your child's belongings before they attend.

#### Please do not send your child's toys or snacks to our summer program.

#### What we will Provide

- 1. All snacks, meals, and beverages.
- 2. Sunscreen and bug spray.
- 3. Lifejackets.
- 4. Transportation, if required.

#### What you can expect from the Staff

- 1. Quality programming that focuses on the enrichment of the child's experiences.
- 2. Curriculum that focuses on the 6 Head Start components.

Education, Nutrition, Health, Culture & Language, Social Support, Parental Involvement

- 3. Professionalism and respect towards the children and parents/caregivers.
- 4. Notification if the schedule has been changed due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 5. Confidentiality about your child or family situations.
- 6. Non-judgemental behaviour towards anyone involved in or out of our program.
- 7. Positive attitude focusing on what we can do -and not what we can't do!!

#### **Summer Camp Dates**

Each session will run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday for 3 weeks.

Class will run from 9:00 until 1:00pm.

Attendance is mandatory for the session you registered for.

Parent participation is mandatory 1x per week.
